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Leader Talking Points

Opportunity: Team-Building Activity

- a. Ask team members for examples on tips on conflict resolution outside of work.
 - 1) Argument with Your Kids: So your kids have an issue with home tasks like cleaning their rooms and you reach a stalemate and don't know what to do next.

Discussion Points

- a. Ask your team for examples on conflict resolution at work.

Team Challenge Activity

- a. Ask the team to offer one or two areas where managing conflict resolution has been an issue.
 - 1) Example: Identify a situation where a team is challenged by a team member who refuses to resolve an issue and instead turns to blaming and ignoring the problem.
 - 2) Ask for a volunteer to take the lead to work with the manager and team on the selected opportunity and report back to team on next steps.

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
